

Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, & Liability Act (CERCLA)


- □ Enacted 1980 and amended in 1996 (42 U.S.C. §9601 et seq.)
- □ Superfund Act
- □ Enables EPA to cleanup orphan sites
- Cleanup enforcement through orders, consent decrees, and settlements
- Can recoup cleanup costs from financially viable individuals and companies
- □ Provides science based cleanup approach
- Prior to CERCLA multiple well documented environmental disasters occurred

Remedial Investigations & Risk Assessments


- □ Remedial Investigation (RI)
 - □ Determine extent of contamination
 - □ Extensive surface and subsurface investigation
 - □ Delineate CoC contamination plumes
 - □ Risk Assessments
 - □ Ecological Risk Assessments
 - □ Human Health Risk Assessments








Feasibility Studies


Always Ready

- □ Feasibility Studies
 - Develop and screen different remedial activities
 - Include alternatives
 - □ Pump and Treat
 - Bacteria Injections
 - □ Groundwater Filtration Systems
 - Excavation
 - Cost analysis
 - Timeline

Remediation technologies used for soil contaminated with heavy metals/metalloids at the field scale










Proposed Plan & Record of Decision

- □ Proposed Plan
 - □ Present preferred alternative to public
 - □ 30-day public comment period
 - Public meetings
- □ Record of Decision (RoD)
 - Technical parameters of remediation
 - Describes how remedy protects human health and environment
 - Includes treatment, engineering and institutional controls, and cleanup levels









Remedial Design & Remedial Action

- □ Remedial Design (RD)
 - □ Engineering design phase
 - □ Develop technical drawings and specifications
 - Provides framework for transition into next phase
- □ Remedial Action (RA)
 - □ Implementation phase of site cleanup
 - Includes Construction Completion and Operational & Functional phases









Construction Completion & Post Construction Completion Activities

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
Construction Completion Physical construction of remediation systems is complete, and remediation is ready to begin. **Post Construction Completion (PCC) Activities** □ Operational and Functional (O&F) □ A remedy becomes O&F either one year after construction is complete, or when the remedy is functioning properly and is performing as designed, whichever is earlier. □ Operation and Maintenance (O&M) □ Enter O&M Phase after O&F Determination Report □ O&M managed by responsible parties, states or other federal agencies □ Five Year Reviews □ Annual Reporting & Progress Reports

Completion of Remediation

- □ Completion Criteria
 - □ EPA, in conjunction with the state, has determined that responsible or other parties have implemented all appropriate response action required.
 - □ Close-out Report
 - □ Approval of close-out by state regulatory agencies and EPA
